On behalf of the Program Committee, it is our pleasure to present the proceedings of the 11th International Symposium on Recent Advances in Intrusion Detection (RAID 2008), which took place in Cambridge, Massachusetts, USA on September 15-17. The symposium brought together leading researchers and practitioners from academia, government and industry to discuss intrusion detection research and practice. Final selection took place at the Program Committee meeting on May 23rd in Cambridge, MA. Twenty papers were selected for presentation and publication in the conference proceedings, and four

papers were recommended for resubmission as poster presentations. As a new feature this year, the symposium accepted submissions for poster presentations, which have been published as extended abstracts, reporting gear-stageresearch, demonstration of applications, or casestudies. Thirty-nine posters were submitted for a numerical review by an independent, three-person s- committee of the Program Committee based on novelty, description, and ev- uation. The subcommittee chose to recommend the acceptance of 16 of these posters for presentation and publication.
